



Call for American Friends of Western Uganda FBO Network Volunteer Support Committee

Terms of Reference

1. Background:

The Western Uganda Faith-Based Organizations Network (WUFBON) is an interfaith umbrella network dedicated to promoting gender justice, combating harmful practices, and advancing sustainable development through population, health, environment & development religious initiatives. To enhance our efforts and expand our impact, we are establishing the American Friends of Western Uganda FBO Network Volunteer Support Committee.

2. Purpose:

The Volunteer Support Committee will provide strategic guidance, fundraising support, and advocacy to strengthen WUFBON's programs and initiatives. The committee will play a crucial role in mobilizing resources and building partnerships to further our mission.

3. Objectives:

Fundraising: Develop and implement fundraising strategies to secure financial support for WUFBON's projects.

Advocacy: Advocate for WUFBON's mission and programs within the American context, raising awareness and support.

Connections with social entrepreneurs, American-based grant makers, Churches, Rotary, Lions Club, and Peace Corps are considered an added advantage.

5. Roles and Responsibilities:

Chairperson: Lead the committee, coordinate meetings, and represent the committee in interactions with WUFBON.

Fundraising Coordinator: Develop and oversee fundraising campaigns and initiatives.

Advocacy Coordinator: Lead advocacy efforts and engage with stakeholders to promote WUFBON's mission.

Partnership Coordinator: Identify and cultivate relationships with potential partners and donors.

Volunteer and Intern Coordinator: Oversee the recruitment and management of volunteers and interns.

General Members: Support the committee's activities, participate in meetings, and contribute to the development and implementation of strategies.

6. Meetings:

The committee will meet quarterly, with additional meetings scheduled as needed. Meetings can be held virtually to accommodate members' locations and schedules.

7. Reporting:

The committee will report to the WUFBON Executive Director, providing updates on activities, progress, and outcomes. Regular reports will be submitted to ensure transparency and accountability.

8. Duration:

Committee members will serve a term of three years, with the possibility of renewal based on performance and commitment.

9. Benefits:

Networking Opportunities: Connect with like-minded individuals and organizations committed to gender justice and sustainable development.

Impact: Contribute to meaningful change and support initiatives that improve the lives of marginalized communities in Western Uganda.

Recognition: Receive acknowledgment for your contributions and support in WUFBON's communications and events.

Logistic Support: Round trip logistic support to Uganda for committee members to participate in key events and activities.

Interested individuals are invited to submit a letter of interest and a brief biography outlining their relevant experience and commitment to WUFBON's mission. Applications will be reviewed by the WUFBON Executive Team.
